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	Any medications that you or anyone in your family needs
	A well-stocked first aid kit (bandages, bandaids, antibacterial ointments, tweezers, etc.)
	Important documents in a ziptop bag (identification, social security cards, birth certificates, important contact information, etc.)
	Flashlight or lantern and plenty of batteries (They also make flashlights that you can power manually by shaking or through a crank)
	A Radio (Preferably crank-powered)
	Ponchos for the entire family
	A Nylon rope (50 ft)
	A tarp
	A waterproof lighter or matches
	Candles
	Bottled water (Enough for at least several days)
	Nonperishable food (Enough for at least several days)
	Silverware and a can opener
	A multi-tool with knife, scissors, pliers, etc.
	Money (You don't know what you may lose in the disaster, and you may need some cash)
